## RANCHO SANTA FE GOLF CLUB AND LA JOLLA COUNTRY CLUB

**JUNE 21-26, 2010**

### **FORMAT:**

#### **Stroke Play Qualifying: Rancho Santa Fe GC and La Jolla CC**

**Monday June 21<sup>st</sup>** – 18 holes of stroke play at both Rancho Santa Fe GC and La Jolla CC with 78 players per course. Tee times begin at 7:30 a.m. in groups of three off tee number one.

**Tuesday June 22<sup>nd</sup>** – 18 holes of stroke play at both Rancho Santa Fe GC and La Jolla CC with 78 players per course. Tee times begin at 7:30 a.m. in groups of three off tee number one.

**PLAYOFF:** Following play at both courses a playoff will take place for the 32<sup>nd</sup> spot at Rancho Santa Fe GC. Players finishing their second round at La Jolla CC should immediately return to Rancho Santa Fe GC.

#### **Match Play: Rancho Santa Fe Golf Club**

**Wednesday June 23<sup>rd</sup>** – first round of match play will take place with 32 players starting at 7:30 a.m. in groups of two off tee number one.

**Thursday June 24<sup>th</sup>** – second round of match play will take place with 16 players starting at 7:30 a.m. in groups of two off tee number one.

**Friday June 25<sup>th</sup>** – quarter-final matches will take place with eight players starting at 7:30 a.m. in groups of two off tee number one.

**Friday June 25<sup>th</sup>** – semi-final matches will take place with four players starting at 1:00 p.m. in groups of two off tee number one.

**Saturday June 26<sup>th</sup>** – 36-hole final match will take place starting at 7:30 a.m. and 12:00 p.m.

## **NORTH/SOUTH CHALLENGE MATCHES**

The North/South Challenge Matches are a two day team competition between the Northern California Golf Association and the Southern California Golf Association which take place during stroke play qualifying on Monday and Tuesday. The winning team will hold the rights to the Roger Lampham Trophy. Each team of six players is selected by their respective association. The final results are based on the best five scores out of six for each of the teams for a two day total score.

### **PAIRINGS**

Pairings and starting times will be emailed to each player and available on the California State Amateur Championship website approximately two weeks prior to the championship: [www.californiaamateur.org](http://www.californiaamateur.org).

### **RULES OF PLAY**

- \*Play is governed by the 2010-2011 USGA Rules of Golf.
- \*A Local Rules Addendum will be distributed at the championship site. Disregard all other club posted local rules.
- \* Distance Measuring Devices (without the capability of measuring slope, wind, etc.) are permitted. Likewise, cell phones that have applications that calculate distance may be used for that purpose only (note: cell phones that also have applications or functions that calculate slope, direction, wind, etc. are not permissible under the rules). Otherwise, cell phone use is not permitted during the stipulated round. This includes checking voicemail messages, e-mail or text messages.
- \*Automotive transportation is prohibited. Push/Pull carts are permitted.

### **TEES AND YARDAGES**

La Jolla CC: Black tee markers and yardages (hole #3 will play from 372 yards)  
Rancho Santa Fe GC: Black tee markers and yardages (a variety of yardages will be used on the par 3's and par 5's)

### **PACE OF PLAY**

The USGA check point pace of play policy will be in effect. The policy is enclosed in this handbook for you to review prior to the championship. If you have any questions please contact the SCGA at (818) 980-3630 or talk to a CGA official prior to your round.

## **ENTRY FEE**

The championship entry fee is \$200. You must contact the SCGA office (Bianca Avina, [bavina@scga.org](mailto:bavina@scga.org)) at 818-980-3630 or 800-554-7242 to provide your credit card information for the championship fee. Players may also mail in a check for the championship fee with the enclosed entry fee certificate. In addition to the tournament rounds, the entry fee includes one practice round at each course, breakfast and lunch each day, and range balls prior to each round. All exempt players have paid the \$200 entry fee and will not be charged any additional fees.

## **DRESS CODE**

### **VERY IMPORTANT – APPLIES TO PLAYERS, CADDIES AND SPECTATORS**

The following dress code is in effect for all players, caddies and spectators (friends, family members, guests, etc.):

Men/Boys: contestants, caddies and spectators must be properly attired on the grounds and in the buildings. Proper attire is considered to be slacks or Bermuda-type shorts (no higher than 5 inches above the center of the front of the knee and no longer than 21 inches in total length), golf shirts with sleeves and collars, and sweaters. Shirrtails must be tucked inside pants. Headwear, caps and visors shall be worn with bills positioned forward and must be removed when entering the clubhouse. Non-metal (soft spikes) golf shoes are required.

Ladies/Girls: Tailored slacks, skirts, dresses, split skirts, Bermuda-type shorts, capris, and appropriate shirts or sweaters are appropriate golf attire. Skirts, shorts and dresses are not to exceed 4 inches from the top of the knee. Caps and visors are to be worn bill forward.

**NOT PERMITTED:** Appropriate dress does not include: collarless t-shirts or shirts with large printing on back, cut-offs, blue jeans or denim of any color or brand, etc., cargo pants or cargo shorts (cargo pockets, back flap and side pockets), baggy or grunge-style clothing, jogging suits, leggings, drawstring or elastic waistband pants or shorts, halter or strapless tops, tube tops, bare or exposed midriffs, t-shirts, undershirts, tank tops or other extreme cut-away tops, stretch pants, tennis/swimming/running attire, single-toed thongs (flip-flops, go-aheads), or metal spiked shoes.

A player or caddie violating this dress code will not be permitted to start the competition. If during play the dress code is violated by either the player or his caddie the violation must be rectified without undue delay or the player will not continue to play and the caddie will not be allowed to perform the acts of a caddie. Spectators in violation will be asked to rectify their situation as well or will have to leave the property.

## **REGISTRATION: REQUIRED FOR ALL CONTESTANTS**

All players must register with CGA staff upon arrival for their practice round on June 19, 20 or before their first round on June 21. Registration tables will be located in front of each clubhouse. At registration you will receive important last-minute information about the host facilities and the tournament. A player ID card will be given to each player that will allow you access to the clubhouse and food and beverage for the week.

## **PRACTICE ROUNDS – CONTESTANTS ONLY**

La Jolla Country Club and Rancho Santa Fe Golf Club will each host one complimentary practice round for each participant based on the parameters in this document. Caddies are permitted to walk with their player during their practice rounds. Caddies will not be allowed to play.

To be fair to all participants, calls for practice rounds will not be accepted until Tuesday, **May 25<sup>th</sup> starting at 8:30 a.m. Reservations will be on a first-come, first-served basis and must be made by Wednesday, June 16<sup>th</sup> before 4:00 p.m.**

NOTE: If you elect to play a practice round between May 27 and June 17 at both clubs, you are not eligible to play another practice round on June 19 or 20.

SCGA and local players are encouraged to practice in the weeks prior to give NCGA and traveling players the opportunity to play the Saturday or Sunday prior to the championship.

Players may walk or use a golf cart during their practice round. Cart fee: \$20. Push/pull carts may be used. Players and caddies must adhere to the dress code in this document.

NOTE: Food and beverage cash purchases will be available from each club's snack bar on June 19 and 20. Food and beverage items will not be available during practice rounds on dates prior to June 19.

### **DRIVING RANGE AND PRACTICE FACILITY**

The driving range, practice chipping and putting areas will be available starting at 6:30 a.m. each day of the competition. The driving range will not be available to players after their stroke play rounds except for play-off participants at Rancho Santa Fe on Tuesday afternoon.

The driving range at La Jolla is limited in distance. Players should avoid hitting balls over the net as players walking down the 9<sup>th</sup> fairway are subject to getting hit by shots over the net. Please use the limited flight golf balls when hitting drivers.

Prior to practice rounds players may only hit one bag of golf balls and will not have access to the driving range until 1 hour prior to their practice round time.

### **TRANSPORTATION**

Automotive transportation is not permitted for players or caddies. Disabled players must file a "Disabled Cart Request" form with the SCGA. Forms may be requested from the SCGA Rules and Competitions Department at (800) 554-7242 or [rules@scga.org](mailto:rules@scga.org).

### **CADDIES**

Players may carry their own golf bag or provide their own caddie. All caddies must adhere to the dress code listed in this document. Caddies will be issued an official CGA caddie bib at the tee prior to each round which must be worn during the round and returned each day.

Players bringing their own caddie are responsible for the conduct of their caddie at the championship.

### **FOOD AND BEVERAGE (PLAYERS ONLY)**

A hosted breakfast (6:00 a.m. – 10:00 a.m.) and lunch (12:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.) will be available Monday and Tuesday at each club. Starting Wednesday the hosted breakfast (6:30 a.m. – 9:00 a.m.) and lunch (11:30 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.) will be at Rancho Santa Fe Golf Club. Players must show their CGA ID cards to receive the complimentary meal. The snack bars at each club will be open for contestants to purchase items with cash.

### **FOOD AND BEVERAGE (CADDIES AND SPECTATORS)**

Caddies, family, friends and spectators will have access to purchase the “players” breakfast and lunch at each club. Each club will accept cash purchases only. The snack bar at each course will also be available for cash purchases. The snack bars at each course are located at the 10<sup>th</sup> tees.

### **CELL PHONES**

The use of cell phones for making phone calls, answering calls, texting, emailing, etc. is not permitted on each course, the clubhouses, or practice facilities. Please use your cell phone in your car only.

### **PARKING**

Ample parking is available for players and spectators at each club. At Rancho Santa Fe GC players, caddies and spectators should park in the upper lot (first right upon entering the parking lot).

### **SPECTATOR INFORMATION**

All spectators must adhere to the dress code and cell phone policies listed in this document. Spectators will not have access to the locker rooms in the clubhouse. Restrooms at La Jolla CC are located at #7 tee, #10 tee (snack bar), #12 fairway and #14 tee. Restrooms at Rancho Santa Fe GC are located at #2 tee, #6 tee, #10 tee (snack bar) and #16 tee.

## **2010 PACE OF PLAY POLICY: STROKE PLAY**

When a group is **out of position** at any check-point the players in the group are liable to penalty under these guidelines. Players in a group that has missed one or more check-points will be liable to penalty according to the following schedule of penalties pending final determination of whether a breach or breaches of these guidelines have occurred:

Check-points will be on completion (flagstick in the hole) of the 5<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> holes.

- 1<sup>st</sup> missed check-point\* – warning
- 2<sup>nd</sup> missed check-point – liable to a one stroke penalty
- 3<sup>rd</sup> missed check-point – liable to a two stroke penalty
- 4<sup>th</sup> missed check-point – liable to disqualification

\* If a group clears the 3<sup>rd</sup> check-point and has not missed any other check-points, but is out of position at the 4<sup>th</sup> checkpoint, each player in the group is liable for a one stroke penalty if in the Committee's view a reasonable effort was not made by the players to complete their round within the allotted time for the final check-point.

### **Allotted Time**

When play is in groups of three, each group is allotted **4 hours and 30 minutes** to complete 18 holes at a pace in accordance with the time chart. When a group falls behind – regardless of the reason - it must regain its position. Time for ball searches, rulings, and walking time between holes is included in the allotted time.

### **Definition of "Out of Position" – Stroke Play**

**FIRST GROUP:** (off the 1<sup>st</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> holes): The first group is **out of position** if takes more than the allotted time to finish a check-point hole.

**FOLLOWING GROUPS:** A following group is **out of position** if it **(a)** takes more than the allotted time to finish a check-point hole **and (b)** completes play of a check-point hole more than 14 minutes after the preceding group completed play of that hole.

Time charts outlining the time per hole, including the finish times for the check-point holes, are listed on the scorecard.

**Check-Points:** Play of the hole must be completed in the following amount of time: Hole #5: 1 hr, 15 minutes / Hole #9: 2 hrs. 15 minutes / Hole #14: 3 hrs. 30 minutes / Hole #18: 4 hrs. 30 minutes.

### **Group Out of Position**

When a group is **out of position** at a check-point, it will be notified by a Check-Point Official. When a group has been notified of a missed check-point, that group is expected to regain its position before reaching the next check-point. If that group reaches the next check-point **out of position** each player in the group may incur the applicable penalty for a breach of these guidelines. Any group that is **out of position** may be monitored by a Rules Rover. A player concerned about a non-responsive (slow) fellow-competitor in his group, who is delaying play, should request a Rules Rover to monitor the group in case the group is or becomes liable to penalty under these guidelines.

### **Final Determination Regarding Breach / Review Process**

Before returning his score card, a player who is liable for penalty during his round may consult with the Pace of Play Committee to determine if he has incurred a penalty under these guidelines. The Pace of Play Committee will determine that a player who has been found to be **out of position** is not in breach of these guidelines only if:

- (a)** the player was delayed by the Committee; or
- (b)** the player was delayed by a circumstance beyond control of the player or the group; or
- (c)** the player was delayed by another player in the group.

A player who was **out of position** during his round and who elects not to consult with the Pace of Play Committee to determine whether he was in breach of these guidelines is deemed to be in breach of these guidelines and incurs a penalty or penalties according to the above schedule of penalties. If a player or group incurs a penalty, penalties are to be applied to the check-point hole where the breach occurred.

## **2010 PACE OF PLAY POLICY: MATCH PLAY**

Rule 6-7 of the Rules of Golf requires that a player “shall play without undue delay.”

**Notes 1 & 2 under 6-7 are in effect.**

### **PENALTY**

#### **MATCH PLAY**

12 minutes per hole – Groups of 2

1<sup>st</sup> Offense - Warning

2<sup>nd</sup> Offense - Loss of hole

3<sup>rd</sup> Offense - Disqualification

#### 1. DEFINITION OF OUT OF POSITION

- a. The first group to start will be out of position if, at any time during the round, the group is behind the allotted time to play.
- b. Any following group will be considered out of position if, at any time during the round, the group is behind the allotted time to play, and when approaching a tee, there is an open par 3 or par 4 hole or the preceding group is on the green of a par 5 hole.

#### 2. MONITORING

- a. If a group is determined to be out of position at any time, the group will be advised that it is out of position and **each player** in the group will be monitored and timed.
- b. If **any player** in a group that is being monitored takes more than 40 seconds to play a stroke, **the player** will automatically incur the applicable penalty for breach of these guidelines.

#### 3. TIMING

- a. Timing shall begin when the Player has had a reasonable opportunity to reach the ball, there is no interference from another person or ball, and it is the player’s turn to play.
- b. The player will be allowed a **few seconds** to select a club. However, any time spent walking backward or forward for measuring or other purposes will count as part of the time taken.
- c. On the putting green, a player will be allowed a **reasonable** time to lift, clean, and replace his ball, repair his ball mark, remove loose impediments and repair other ball marks on the player’s line of putt.
- d. When a group has regained its position, timing will be discontinued.
- e. In the event that the group is monitored later in the round, previous warnings and penalties will carry over.
